Our group "Sheriff" was a giant of a man! By that, he was not only big of stature; he had a heart for the Lord and kids to match. He did not tire, nor did I ever see him without a smile on his face. I knew our teen's group the Ranchers was going to be especially blessed with him as our leader.

As we began our agenda for the day, the kids were pretty typical kids...they had gotten up much earlier than normal, most had been "encouraged" to come, and some were just not happy that they didn't get to go with their best friend's group, and were determined "not" to have a good time... Since it was my first time as well to the camp, I wondered how we were ever going to change those little minds...

Thankfully it was my first time as a volunteer, but it was not the first camp for S.V.Y.R.! Agendas were all allotted a certain amount of time, not too much, not to little! It was amazing! We moved from one activity to the next, until suddenly it was lunch and a short informational meeting about the afternoon activities. Lunch was good and filling, and we started out refreshed for the afternoon.

Our team started the afternoon with the OBSTACLE course!! This course was amazing! Our group had done some quiet crafts and nature things that morning, but this was Different!!!

I got to man the rope for the rope jump! OH my goodness (it really was fun, I tested it)!! Now let me tell you, our group was all girls, but these girls were TOUGH!

One thinks of OBSTACLE as something that stops or slows down progress... Well, at the Ranch, with the Lord's guidance, faithful, loving volunteers, the OBSTACLE pulls the team together! And I was blessed to get to be at the Rope! You grabbed this Rope, (could have been the Lord's hand?) and propelled yourself off this huge stack of hay bales, over this ditch, until you landed safely on the other side!

There were many other things to do on this course, but this is the one that opened the door to these kids hearts, when it came to learning about "faith"...Some were not as brazen as others, and the team cheered them on, encouraging them, clapping, caring...until everyone "took the Leap of Faith"!
